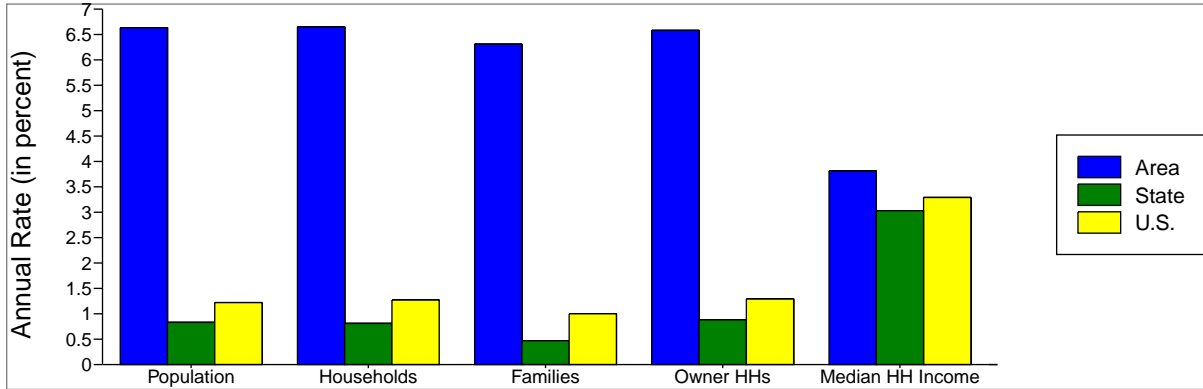

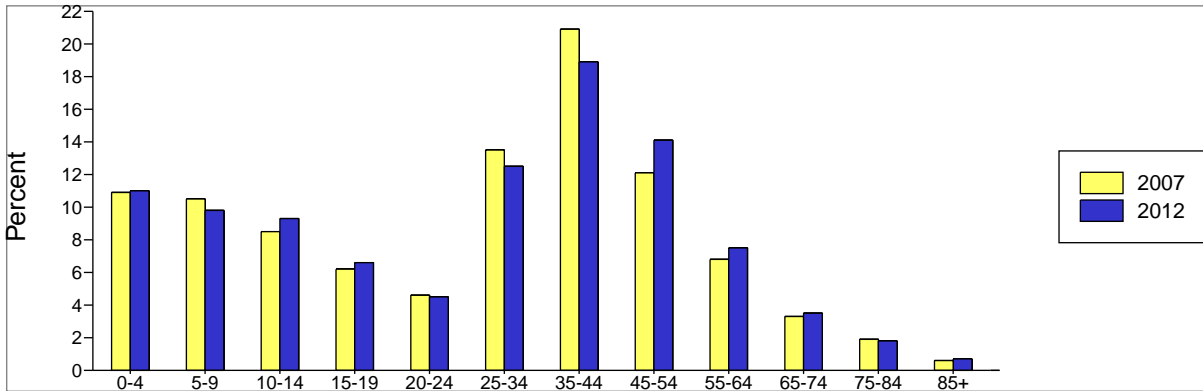

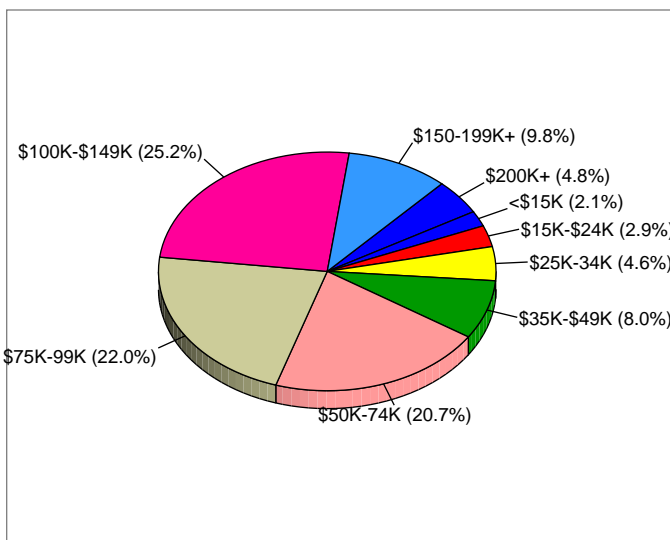

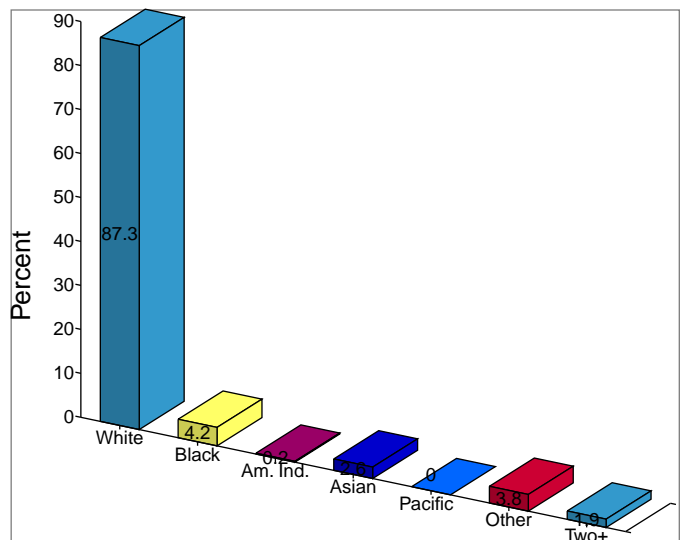
Population by Age
